



5.-Recommendations: 7 Priority Actions

- 1. Improve classification systems and official statistics
- 2. Clarify NWFP products' and producers' regime, to set order in the primary production phase
- 3. Adapt **taxation** and **labour** requirements to the **complementarity** of the activities in the primary production of NWFP
- 4. Improve forest and land management for NWFP
- 5. Impose **traceability** to NWFP in Europe and extend improved **FLEGT and EUTR regulations** to NWFP from other countries
- 6. Approve European and national NWFP programs
- 7. Improve sectoral governance and administrative coordination
