

PROJECTS ONEforest (Horizon 2020)

ONEForest is developing a multi-criteria decision support system for joint forest management to enhance forest resilience, align stakeholder interests, and ensure sustainable wood flows. It aims to harmonize forest ecosystem services, helping forest owners evaluate optimal management methods under current and future conditions.

DIGIMEDFOR leverages digital solutions, geospatial technology, AI, and ICT to enhance forest monitoring and management, promoting sustainable wood production while optimizing ecosystem services.

The project involves 21 partners from 10 different countries in Europe and the Mediterranean Basin, including Italy, France, Spain, Tunisia, Greece, Ukraine, Croatia, Finland, Slovakia, and Turkey. **The Montagne Fiorentine Model Forest, along with Provence Model Forest and Istria Model Forest, will manage case studies within their territories** and promote the project's goals through dissemination and engagement events.

L'Accord de Paris en action : Intensifier la restauration des forêts et des paysages pour atteindre les objectifs des contributions déterminées au niveau national (IKI + FAO project)

Funded by the International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German BMU and FAO, this project supports the Paris Agreement through forest restoration efforts.

Moroccan partners include Ifrane Model Forest and Midelt Initiative Model Forest.

Key activities include:

- Restoration in designated sites identified by Moroccan partners.
- Two exchanges in 2024 (one in Morocco and one in Italy), where a delegation of forestry professionals will visit to exchange knowledge on forest management practices.
- Field visit to Morocco was held in October 2023 by the Secretariat to validate the executive plans of the two Moroccan entities involved.



2024 – EDUCASE project - improve Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Accessibility trough

forest pedagogy and environmental education for Forest and Landscape Restoration.

With these tools:

- Joëlette (a special wheelchair to ensure accessibility to mountain trails for those with motor disabilities),
- Photo traps
- PlantsPlay (sensors that translate electrical changes in plants into sounds),
- Kit for **wolf howling** or **deer roaring**
- Orienteering kit
- Time Lapse camera
- Digital microscope and climate station

To present the tools and their potential we organazed a dedicated workshop in Italy in March 2024, inviting representatives from MF of Ifrane (Marocco), Western Macedonia (Greece), Media Valle dell'Aterno (Italy), Provence (France), Istria (Croatia), Tlemcen (Algeria), and Voskopoja Model Forest Initiative (Albania) and as guest Juan Pablo Rodriguez Garavito from Colombia, delegate of the Latin-American Model Forest Network. It has been the perfect occasion for sharing knowledge among the MFs of the Mediterranean on the potential of education and dissemination to include the communities in the FLR projects.
